You will be disqualified if all these items below are not included. Check your work!

- 1. Write an essay (maximum 1 page, typed, no less than 10 pt. font), choosing only 1 of these 5 topics:
 - What is the greatest lesson in humility you have ever learned, and what did it teach you?
 - What do you feel is the greatest invention of your lifetime? How has this invention impacted your life and your future?
 - As celebrities seek publicity with shock value and sports figures seem to dominate the headlines, how would you encourage a younger child to identify with a role model? What characteristics should a good role model exemplify, and where should a child look to find such a role model?
 - Have you read a book that has significantly impacted or even changed the course of your life?
 Give a brief overview of the book and several examples of how the reading of this book impacted your life.
 - If you could change anything about the political system and elections in the USA, what would you change and why?
- 2. Submit a signed letter of confirmation of eligibility from IMAWA member company owner or manager other than your parent or spouse. This letter should be on company letterhead and is required to verify student's eligibility to apply for scholarship. (See eligibility reminder above.).
- 3. Grade transcripts.
